ACT LIKE MEN

Last weekend I had the opportunity to attend the Memphis of Men Conference. The speakers were Jonathan Evans, Donnie Smith (CEO Tyson Chicken), James McDonald (Walk in the Word) and former Clemson head coach and current sports analyst, Tommy Bowden. It's hard to remember attending a conference where all the speakers assembled live on such a large scale of notoriety. All their messages had an overarching theme, **Act Like Men**.

You may not initially recognize the name, Jonathan Evans, but his father is Dr. Tony Evans, the famous minister in Texas. His sister is Priscilla Shirer who starred in the movie, War Room, and who has authored several books. Jonathan played in the NFL for five years (San Diego Chargers and Dallas Cowboys) and currently serves as the Chaplin for the Dallas Cowboys. We began showing his message last Wednesday night in our Men's class.

Jonathan Evans referenced the story of Abraham. Abraham was called to leave everything he felt comfortable with in life and move to an unfamiliar place and destination that GOD had not even revealed to him. **GOD's call is often unsettling!** Why would Abraham leave a place where he was so settled, so comfortable in his life? His point, "many of us need to accept GOD's call and get unsettled from our settled places in life." If we are unwilling to accept GOD's call then GOD will give it to the "next man up." As the older generation that came out of Egypt refused to walk in purity and righteousness, GOD caused them to wander for forty years till they all died. He let the next generation enter the promise land instead. May we have the strength and faith to move from our settled places when GOD calls. Are you listening?
