LIVING IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD

(PART 4)

"I AM A FRIEND"

Last week in our message we discussed Jesus' statement in John 10, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays his life down for the sheep...my sheep listen to my voice; I know them and they follow me." This week we want to discuss another relationship aspect we have with our heavenly Father, and that is, a friend.

Jesus tells us in John, "My command is this; Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one that this, that he lay down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you," (John 15:12-15).

In one week we have gone from being a sheep to a friend. But once again, Jesus speaks of his relationship being one of sacrifice for those he cares for and loves. Jesus, the shepherd, loves the sheep. Jesus, the master teacher, does not see us as servants, but as friends whom he loves deeply. Think about all the songs we sing that are centered on "friendship."

Who is your best friend? Is it your spouse? Is it someone you have known for a long time? How often do you speak to them? Wouldn't you agree that communication was an essential part of developing that relationship and continuing that relationship? So it is with Jesus and his followers.

Do you remember that wonderful story in the book of Exodus when GOD speaks to Moses? I recognize there were numerous times that GOD and Moses conversed, but specifically when the Scripture says, "The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks with his friend," (Exodus 33:11).

Today I want us to entertain the thought that GOD not only desires to speak to us as a Creator to His creation (Romans 1:20), but He also wants to speak to us as a friend. "What a Friend We Have in Jesus."

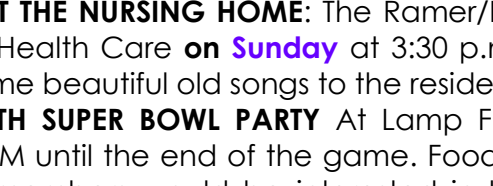
