Therefore, we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

These are the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians 4:16, and they are some of my favorite words spoken by him. To me, Paul is speaking of a fresh start, a new day.
