DO YOU KNOW HOW TO WORSHIP?

I realize you might think that is a ridiculous questions, especially to those who have been attending worship assemblies the better part of their lives. But seriously, do you know how to worship? Do you know how to praise GOD with thanksgiving for His redemption and salvation of your soul? Do you know how to worship GOD when you have lost a loved one? Do you know how to worship when you have a child struggle in their faith and being overtaken by the deceptions of the evil one?

Too often we just show up and go through the motions of singing, communion, prayer, giving and the study of the word; then out the door for Sunday lunch. We may not realize worship is intended to transform us. In fact, we should be different, better, stronger when we leave worship than we came in!

True worship begins with a high and elevated view of GOD. In Isaiah 6, when Isaiah saw the throne and the seraphs with six wings flying about and calling to one another, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory," he was shaken to his core. Isaiah cried, "Woe is me! I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips and mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." He was changed, different. We can also learn from John's vision in Revelation 4-5. In those chapters John sees all of creation gathered around the throne of GOD in worship. It overwhelmed John.

When Job lost all of his wealth, had his servants killed and all ten of his children died in the wind storm, he fell to the ground and worshiped. Can you worship in your brokenness? In our culture when people, even believers, have experienced loss or brokenness, they go out and get drunk. Instead of drawing near to GOD, they drown their pain and sorrow with anything they think will anesthetize them from hurting. Worship is GOD's healing balm in our brokenness and sorrow. As the great hymn declares, "Where Could I Go, But to the LORD." My hope and desire is for us to re-evaluate how we view worship, and discover that worship is designed to change our lives from the inside out.
