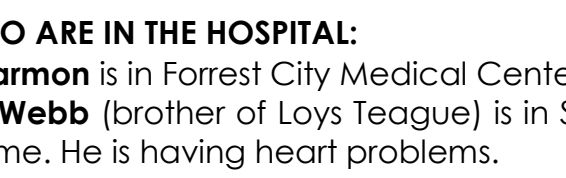
PRAYER BREAKFAST: Join us at 6:30 AM in Rash Hall.
