Ministry at MoSt

This month we will be looking at all the different ministries we have here at the Missouri Street church. It is exciting to recognize the numerous and wide variety of ministries we have taking place in our congregation, especially in regard to outreach ministries and missions. There are several intentional goals we hope to accomplish during the month of August.

First, to thank GOD and give him praise for working through our community of faith. When you begin noticing all the ministries being carried out here in our church family, you realize a lot of lives are being influenced with the good news about Jesus. We often preach the gospel first by how we live and act among others we associate with in our world. Never underestimate the value of your example; there is someone always watching. So, thank you, Father in Heaven, for working in our lives and giving us these wonderful opportunities to serve and minister to others.

Second, our hope and desire is to call people to ministry. When reading the Bible we note that many were called by GOD to lead others. Abraham was called, Moses was called, David, Jeremiah, and many other prophets were all called to ministry. Jesus called his disciples and these men were from all walks of life. But GOD also called women. Eve, Sarah, Hagar, Rebekah, Rachel, Miriam, Rahab, Deborah, Jael, Ruth, Hannah, Esther, Mary the mother of Jesus, Mary and Martha, Mary Magdalene, Dorcus, Lydia, and Priscilla just to name a few. We are so blessed at MoSt to have numerous women to lead and serve in our congregation.

Third, to encourage the right kind of leadership among our ministry teams, biblical leadership. In simplest terms, biblical leadership is about serving. The only kind of authentic, scriptural and spiritual leadership we read about in the Bible is one who leads by serving. Husbands lead by serving, "Husbands love your wives AS Christ loved the church," (Eph. 5:25). And we all know that Christ Jesus laid his life down for the church, "Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve and give his life a ransom for many," (Matt. 20:28). The disciples were called to lead by serving as well as Paul the apostle. The same is true for the women in Scripture, they lead by serving others. Elders, deacons and ministers are called to serve the church.

Fourth, to teach the importance of mentoring others into ministry. *GOD NEVER INTENDED THE CHURCH TO BE A ONE MAN SHOW!* In fact, the church is described as a body with many parts, many members. Everyone has a place and a part in the kingdom. The Spirit has given us gifts in order that we might serve and do it for the common good of the church (1 Cor. 12:7,11-18). Jesus mentored the disciples, Paul mentored Barnabas, Silas, Timothy and John Mark. Lydia is leading and mentoring a group of women who were meeting outside the city of Philippi near a river.

Let us prayerfully consider our calling and note we are ALL called to lead and to serve in our church family. It is most important to understand that living out this calling is directly related to our growth and maturity in the faith. GOD has called us to serve one another, (Galatians 5:13).
