Transitions in the Church

It has never been an easy task to create change. Whether it is our country, our community or in the church, change doesn't come easy. When the nation of Israel left Egypt, change did not come easy. In fact at times some of them wanted to lead the people back to Egypt. When Jesus encountered the religious leaders of his day, they resisted the change he brought in his teaching and in the way he treated sinners. The apostles were also resisted by the Sanhedrin who commanded them to stop speaking and teaching in the name of Jesus. Stephen pointed out the resistance of his Jewish audience when he said, "You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit," (Acts 7:51). More resistance was found when the Gentiles accepted the gospel and the Pharisees wanted them to be circumcised and obey the Law of Moses, (Acts 15:5).

Why is change so difficult? One reason is because change can make us feel uncomfortable. Change takes us into unknown areas we haven't fully explored and it is easier to remain in our comfort zones. Two, people resist change because they believe they will lose something of value, or fear they will not be able to adapt to the new ways. Being detailed, answering questions and helping others to see the benefit of change can help ease this tension.

Over the next few Sundays, beginning September 8, we will be implementing the Growth Track. This is a new program that will be taught in the auditorium during Bible classes and from the pulpit to help the entire congregation understand better who we are as a church and how we can increase our ministry participation. These two goals, if accepted and implemented, can increase our spiritual maturity and lead to better discipleship. This Growth Track (101-401) will be a tool and resource we can use to assist new members and new families in acclimating into our church family here at MoSt.

I want to encourage everyone to attend. If you typically do not attend Bible classes, I am asking you to make a special effort to attend these sessions on Sunday morning so you can be aware of the information contained in 101-401. Briefly, Church 101 helps us to understand who we are as a congregation. Essentials 201 lays out the characteristics of a disciple, a follower of Jesus Christ. Discovery 301 helps everyone to discover their personality and spiritual gifts. Ministry Team 401 introduces members to all the various ministries and how to be involved and serve. I pray and hope everyone will make an extra effort to be here and participate in the Growth Track.
