Christmas in Crownpoint

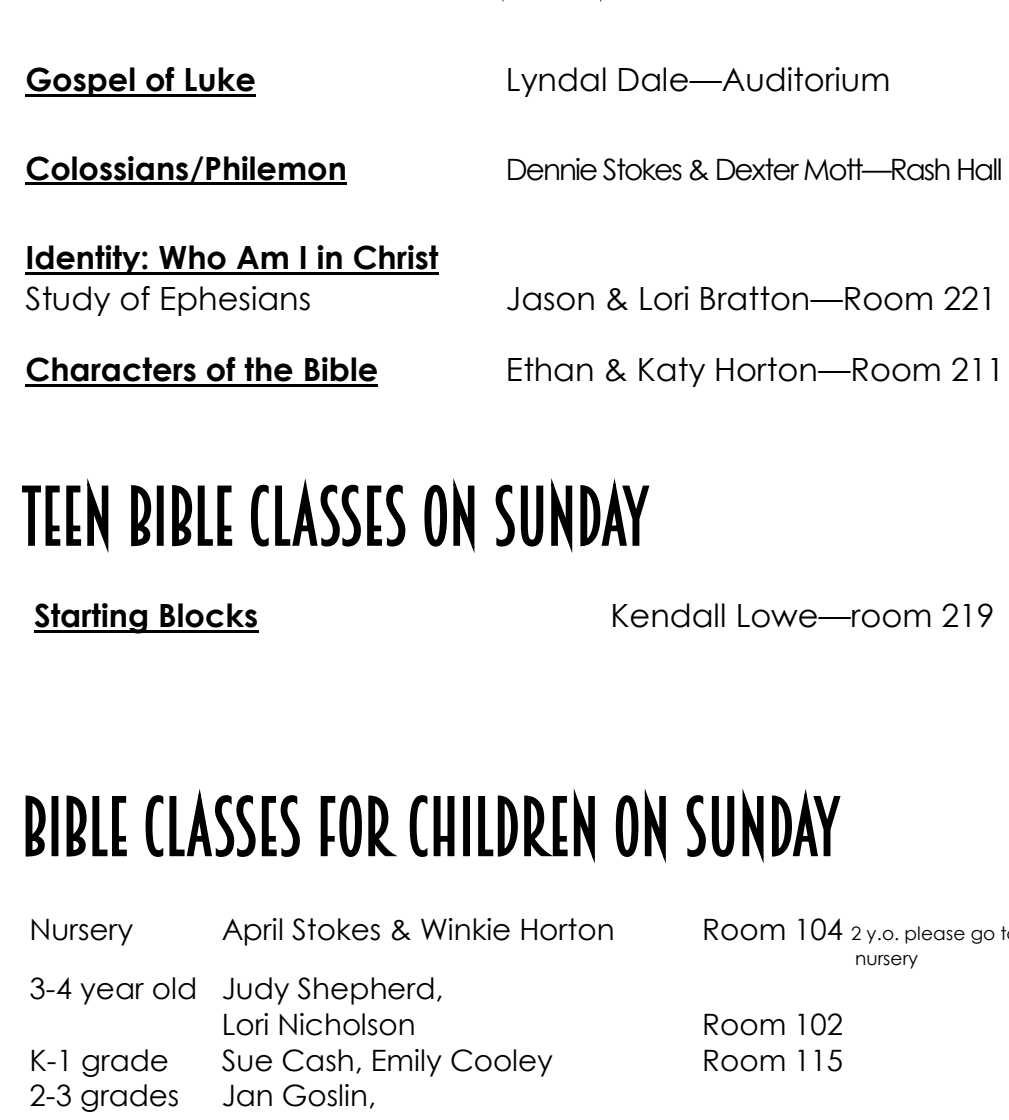
Are you surprised to see Christmas trees in the foyer? It is hard for me to put trees up this early. I like to get through one holiday before starting another.
