### GRIEF RECOVERY VIRTUAL GALA on Nov. 19:

- In 2018 we hosted a Grief Recovery Workshop here at MoSt. David Matthews, Founder and Director of **Spark of Life**, shared with us the great need to help those who are suffering from devastating losses in their life. Since that Workshop, the MoSt church has hosted 4 Grief Recovery Courses. They are offered to both our members at MoSt and to others in our community.
- **Spark of Life** hosts weekend Retreats throughout the year for individuals to attend. These Retreats are held all over the country and people are invited to attend at a minimal cost. Why does Spark of Life do this? David Matthews says that often the case with many of those who are being helped are unable to afford the entire cost of the Retreat. Seminars that David and his wife Debbie conduct, along with donations from churches and individuals, all of these efforts allow grieving and hurting people to attend a Grief Recovery Retreat.

- **Spark of Life** typically has four Fund Raisers every year in order to raise funds to carry out this important ministry. David Matthews, is asking our congregation for help. Because of the COVID-19, every single Fund Raiser has been cancelled in 2020. In response to these cancellations, on November 19, **Spark of Life** will host a "Virtual Gala" to raise funds for these Retreats. David has contacted Katie Hollis to help coordinate this outreach.
