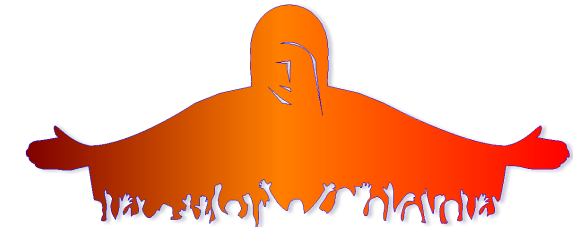
THE WEEK OF THANKSGIVING
